Cherokee blends comfort, value and versatility

Silsbee Ford is offering a clean CARFAX 2020 Jeep Cherokee Latitude that combines practical SUV utility, modern technology and an affordable advertised payment. Finished in Bright White Clearcoat with a black interior, the front-wheel-drive Cherokee has 62,107 miles. Its 2.4-liter four-cylinder engine produces 180 horsepower and 171 pound-feet of torque. A nine-speed automatic transmission helps provide smooth operation and an EPA-estimated 22 mpg in the city and 31 mpg on the highway. The Cherokee is a comfortable choice for commuting, family transportation or weekend travel. Its cabin includes cloth seating, six-way manually adjustable front seats and a 60/40 split-folding rear seat that expands the available cargo area. Three 12-volt power outlets, six speakers and a seatback storage pocket add everyday convenience. Technology is one of this Latitude's strongest points. The 7-inch Uconnect

touchscreen supports Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, allowing drivers to connect compatible smartphones for music, navigation and communication. Bluetooth, SiriusXM satellite radio and voice-operated hands-free calling are also included. The exterior features LED headlights, daytime running lights and taillights. Black lower-body cladding and fender flares give the Cherokee a rugged appearance, while chrome grille accents, roof rails and a rear spoiler add visual appeal. Heated power side mirrors and keyless entry provide additional convenience. Standard safety equipment includes a rearview camera, four-wheel anti-lock brakes, braking assist, stability control, traction control and electronic brake-force distribution. The Cherokee also has front, knee, side and side-curtain airbags, along with child-safety door locks and LATCH child-seat anchors. The 2020 Cherokee received a four-star overall safety rating from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. It earned five stars in side-crash testing and four stars in frontal-crash and rollover testing. Buyers should confirm with Silsbee Ford whether this vehicle includes any optional driver-assistance packages. The advertised vehicle price is \$13,695 before the \$225 dealer documentation fee, bringing the listed selling price to \$13,920 before tax, title and license charges. Qualified buy-

ers may finance the Cherokee through Ally at \$204.08 per month for 72 months with \$2,054 down and a 7.31% annual percentage rate. Total scheduled payments are listed at \$14,693.76. The offer is subject to approved credit, residential restrictions and other dealership terms. The offer expires Sept. 30, 2026.
